David grew up in England and took his first degree at the University of Oxford (1979). After working as an Administrative Officer in the Hong Kong Government for thirteen years (1979–92) he returned to the UK and obtained a D Phil in Oriental Studies in 1998, also from the University of Oxford. After a spell working as an editor and translator in Taiwan (1999–2002), he came back to Hong Kong in 2002 and worked as an Academic Editor until his retirement in 2016, firstly at HKU (2002–8) and more recently at CUHK (2008–16). He left CUHK in 2016 and has since been running his own commercial editing business in Hong Kong. He has an excellent track record in helping his clients to secure grant funding, particularly during the annual GRF/ECS exercise. David has already built up a substantial clientele of satisfied customers at CUHK, who appreciate that his high-quality editing gives them the competitive edge they need to secure grant funding and publish their research papers.
