## Learning Outcomes

1. Major Programme:

Through their training in anthropology, students will:
(1) understand the world's cultural diversity and cultural commonality;

(5) be able to design and carry out different kinds of projects using anthropological tools and perspectives; and
(6) be able to think critically and perceptively about their society and the world.
