Programme Objectives

The programme specifically aims to provide advanced academic and practical instructions on music and its broader cultural contexts to equip students with the critical skills and acumen they need in order to thrive in their future endeavors. It is designed not only for individuals who currently work in the music field but also music lovers with strong musical backgrounds from other professions.

UGC's Targeted TPg Programmes Fellowships Scheme

- Fellowships are available for outstanding local students enrolled in MA in Music programme.
- Each fellowship awardee receives subsidy from the UGC and pays only HK\$42,100 for tuition fee.









Admission Requirements

- (A) Applicants should have:
 - Graduated from a recognized university and obtained a Bachelor's degree, normally with honours not lower than Second Class; or
 - 2. Graduated from an honours programme of a recognized university with a Bachelor's degree, normally achieving an average grade of not lower than "B" in undergraduate courses; or
 - 3. Completed a course of study in a tertiary educational institution and obtained professional or similar qualifications equivalent to an honours degree.
- (B) Applicants must also meet the "English Language Proficiency Requirement" as stipulated by the Graduate School. Please refer to the Graduate School website for details.

Programme Requirements

To qualify for the award of the Master of Arts in Music, students must successfully complete a total of EIGHT courses (24 units), including at least ONE course from each of the three study areas: "Music and Society", "Music, Industry, and Creativity" and "Style and Interpretation". Students also need to achieve a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above.
